

## Woodlands Archaeology Workshop.

A Woodlands Archaeology Workshop will be taking place on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> December at the Coventry Colliery Sports and Social Club. The workshop will consist of a talk in the morning, which will discuss types of archaeology you would expect to find in woodland areas; management of woodlands; the use of historical documents in researching archaeological features and methods of recording archaeological features in woodland areas. In the afternoon we will go for a walk through Bunson Woods where we will look at a variety of archaeological features.

The talk will start at 9.30am, but participants are welcome to arrive from 9.00am. A bar is located in the same room as the lecture where participants can buy tea and coffee. There will also be a mid morning break for refreshments. We aim to have an early lunch at 12.00. Once we have finished lunch we will visit Bunson Woods which is within walking distance of the Club. The site visit will last a couple of hours depending on weather and light conditions. Participants can leave their cars in the Club car park for the whole day.

The workshop is free of charge. You are welcome to attend for just the morning or the afternoon, as convenient. Please bring your own snacks and lunch as food is not available at the Club. The Management of the Club have requested that participants only consume drinks in the clubhouse bought from the bar. The Club is located on Bennetts Road, Keresley, Coventry, CV7 8HY.
